First of all, I want to let you know that I thought the recent meeting went very well. I wish I could have been there in person, but I and my team were very happy with our attendance virtually. Great job to everyone involved! We're looking forward to working with everyone as we move forward this year.

I'd like to request some assistance from the Center for Civic Design. We believe they could help us improve our 2024 Voter Guide. I've attached a sample of a couple of these mailings we used in the past. We do not use the NCOA to do the NVRA required verification of our voter rolls, but instead do a mailing to all of the registered voters in the county every two years. In 2016 we decided to do a Voter Guide for the upcoming state elections. It's been very well received by the voters, but I think we can improve it.

Arizona also has a complicated system for our Active (used to be called Permanent) Early Voting list mailing. We'd like to see if they can help us develop a less legalize mailing to our voters that explains the process.

I'd appreciate it if you could direct me to the correct person to talk to about these two projects.

Again, thanks for the work you are doing to help election administration in the U.S. It's truly appreciated. Also, let me know if you need anything from me.

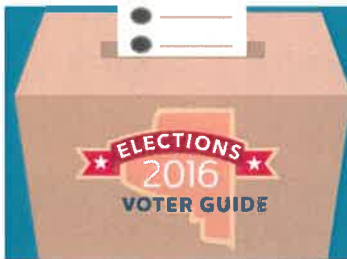

Any registered voter with a mailing address within Arizona may request to be placed on the Permanent Early Voter List (PEVL). **Voters on the PEVL will automatically receive an early ballot by mail for all elections in which they are eligible to participate.**

Steps we take to ensure your vote counts:

**SAFETY AND SECURITY** is designed into every step, from voter registration, early voting and election day boards to tabulation and final canvassing of results.

**EVERY FUNCTION** and responsibility separated and protected by layers of checks and balances, including live-camera streaming of bi-partisan counting boards.

**PHYSICAL SAFEGUARDS** that control access to equipment and/or ballots also detect tampering or malicious activity.

**PROTECTIONS** include elections personnel background checks, building keypad access, 24-7 closed-circuit camera systems, and chains of custody seals and locks.

**AIR-GAP SYSTEM** protects state-of-the-art voting and tabulation equipment without Internet access to eliminate data/equipment hacking.

**BALLOTS ARE REGULARLY RETRIEVED** from secured drop boxes by at least two people of opposite political parties, with Logs and Seals audited and retained.

### New In 2022

Due to a recent change in state law, the Permanent Early Voting List (PEVL) is now called the Active Early Voting List (AEVL). If you were already on the PEVL, you will now be listed as an Active Early Voter and will continue to receive early ballots by mail.



**If you are listed as an Active Early Voter**, you will automatically receive a ballot by mail approximately three weeks before each election in which you are eligible to vote. If you wish to be removed from the Active Early Voter List, or to cancel mailing of early ballots for one or more elections, please contact the Recorder's Office.

**If you are NOT an Active Early Voter**, you will receive a sample ballot before each election notifying you where you may vote for that election.

**You must update your voter registration whenever you change your residence address, name, or political party preference.**

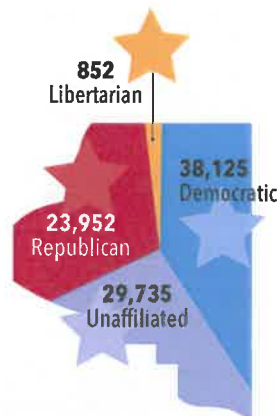

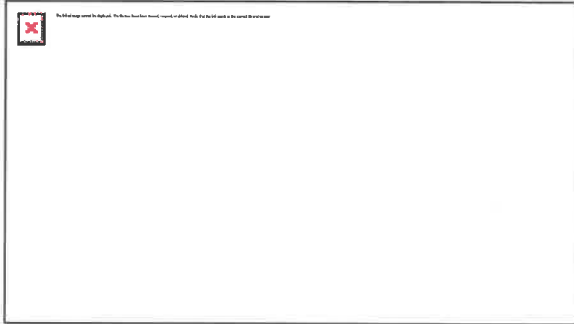
